Min 01/BEK/13/3/2024 - REMARKS BY THE SUB-CHIEF AGNES

The meeting started at 10.00a.m and ended at 12.15a.m at Bekibon Sub-County Chief's Office with a word of prayer lead by Nancy Boskwony followed by self-introduction.

Min 02/BEK/13/3/2024 - BRIEFING AT THE SITE

Tenderers were informed of the day's programme. The registration of the Tenderers started at 10.15am and went on up to 12.15am.



It was emphasized that this pre-tender site visit was not mandatory and there is no certificate but the visit was very important as they would carry out the assessment of the works and fill in the tender document without difficulties.

They were reminded that the proposed Water Supply Project is in Kabuswo Village in Marigat Location in Marigat Ward in Mariga Sub-County.

The following project components were highlighted to the entire project attendant.

Components of the Project

- 1) Intake works – Weir and spring protection
- 2) Weir Chamber
- 3) Pipes and fittings
- 4) Gravity main distance 300m
- 5) Rising main
- 6) Cattle trough
- 7) Communal Water Main
- 8) 50m³ Masonry Sump
- 9) 100m³ Masonry Tank to be constructed at chief office compound.
- 10) Pump house with pump unit
- 11) Fencing and gate installation -200m perimeter

The team then proceeded to the proposed project site.

Min 03/BEK/13/3/2024 - BEKIBON WSP SITE

At the site the pretenders were shown the area to construct the intake weir and the chamber, the 50m³ sump, the pump house, the cattle trough, the communal water point, 100m³ masonry tanks which is to be constructed at the chief compound, fencing and gate installation. The tenders were also shown the area to install the rising main and the gravity main.

Min 04/BEK/13/3/2024 - MATTERS ARISING

i) Issue of access Road: -

Tenderers were assured the bush clearance for the access road would be done by the community people with the help of the area chief before the project implementation.



2) Land Issue: -

The tenderers were assured the land is a Government /Public land and covers approximately 15 acres.

3) Security Issue: -

The community people were reminded that once the project is completed it would be handed over to them for operation and maintenance and therefore should start planning on security issues for all the project.

Min 05/BEK/13/3/2024 - CLOSING MEETING

Tenderers were reminded of the importance of the Pre-tender site visit and told that any issue concerning the tenders that is not clear can be clarified so long as it is requested seven days before the final day of submitting the tenders.

Since there were no other queries the meeting ended at 2.15pm with a word of prayer lead by Pastor Philemon Tallam.
